In addition to the above, all Station House Officers are hereby nominated as Data Collection Officers for this project. All SHOs shall detailed two Police Personnel from their Police Station for the data collection and entry through the mobile Application (ERekha).The name of the Police Personnels of each P.S shall be furnished to Dysp NC. District Police Computer Cell will monitor the server and database of this project. One Civil Police Officer of District Cyber Cell is detailed to assist the Monitoring Team.

All Station House Officers are directed to submit detailed report regarding data collection and entry in every month to the Nodal Officers and Nodal Officers will prepare a consolidated report in this regard and will submit the same to the District Police Chief, Malappuram on 5th day of the succeeding Month. DySP NC shall convene a monthly conference and submit a monthly report to the undersigned.


Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Branch, Malappuram shall ensure the presence of Special Branch Field Staff during the enumeration.
