
They are not eligible for joining time since the transfer is ordered at their request. Their seniority in Malappuram district will be reckoned only with effect from their date of joining duty in this district. The District Police Chiefs concerned may relieve the CPOs immediately after obtaining an undertaking from each CPOs to the effect that they are willing to be transferred to this district on loss of seniority in the KCP and the same may be pasted in their Service Books. The details of PR, if any, pending against them may be intimated to this office. Due to administrative exigencies, the Unit Heads concerned are requested to relieve the transferees urgently. If they do not report within 15 days from the date of issue of this order, it will be presumed that they are unwilling to join in this district.
